









Born and raised in Los Angeles, Richard Becker found sculpture while living in Europe in the mid-1990's.

He has studied sculpture at the Escola d'Art Barcelona, Vaugel Studios Venice Beach and at the Los Angeles Art Academy.

Richard holds a Master of Engineering Management from Stanford University and

several technology patents. He has received the National Sculpture Society's Edward Fenno-Hoffman Prize for an uplifting body of sculptural works.



In 2010 Richard was elected into the National Sculpture Society, the nation's oldest and largest, founded in the 1800's, New York City.

His works are in public and private collections in the US, UK and Europe.
